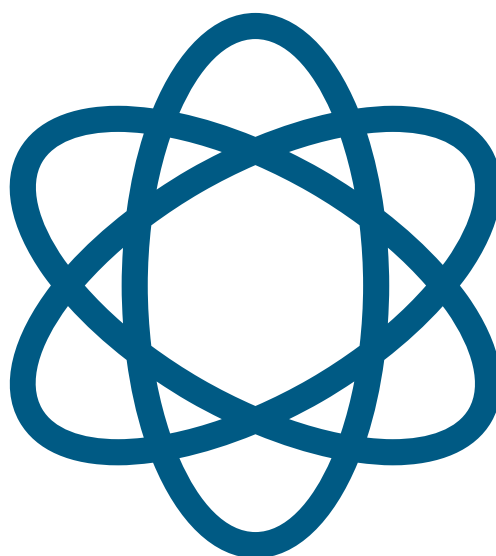


Nuclear Explained

Possible topics: how a power plant works, the basics of fission, nuclear as clean energy, everyday uses of radiation, nuclear medicine, etc

Submissions should be uploaded to youtube.com. A 100-200 word summary of your video & intended audience along with the video link should also be submitted. Interested sections should email Matthew Jasica (m.jasica1@gmail.com) for a complete set of rules and instructions.

Winners will be chosen based on engaging/entertaining messaging, audience appropriate content, factual accuracy, presentation quality, and popularity (determined via vote in late March). Judges will be drawn from ANS and NAYGN.

Things To Consider:

- Audience! Is this for 7 year olds? High school students? Parents? Politicians?
- Messaging! Audience should learn something about nuclear and come away with a positive experience associated with nuclear.
